












I got new friends [3. What did you benefit from the project or what influence did the project have on you?]











Increased motivation [3. What did you benefit from the project or what influence did the project have on you?]





Increased ICT scills [3. What did you benefit from the project or what influence did the project have on you?]





Increased knowledge about partner countries and cultures [3. What did you benefit from the project or what influence did the project have on you?]







5. How do you assess the organizing aspects of the project meetings (programs, schedule etc), where you participated?





6. How satisfied are you with the hosting families (or hostels where you stayed during the project meetings)?





7. How satisfied are you with your own school coordinating teachers involved in the preparations of the project meetings and visits (e.g. providing you all the needed information and help before and during the visits)?





8. Would you like to visit the country you have been during the project meeting again in the future?




